“Our Beloved Motherland”

I write this text as an official presidential candidate for election (October 9) in Poland, I am a candidate on behalf of the National Citizen Coalition, which is not a political party, but a popular movement. In a relatively short time the NCC managed to collect over 260,000 signatures of support (100,000 required by law) to comply with my registration. We do not need much money because morality and honesty are on our side. Once again we have a situation "Us" and "Them", as if nothing has ever changed. Our political opponents like chameleons have changed their colors to stand on a political chessboard in a formation shah-matt. I am certain that our movement will manage to fight their falsehoods even it will be uneven fight. I do not believe that this time the same people, their smooth talk, new clothes and promises of chicken that lay golden eggs will trick Poles. It is time to say that Poland during the last 15 years has been managed by corruptive ignorant, who had no vision of economic growth. Now, thanks to my registration as a candidate, I will be able to present my own vision for future development of Poland.

Today I see my beloved Motherland as country that is poor and tired of long exploitation, but beautiful and proud of its roots. I want my beloved Motherland to be happy without stress, because only men in good mood can fight poverty. When I say that things will get better right away after we win the election, unfriendly press yells that I am a liar. I always assure my countrymen that it will get better because man feels good in his own home. Our citizens have the right to defense against invisible hand of a government thief, who like a vampire, steals during the nights what good men accomplished during the days. Man free of this nightmare feels better because he is free.

Don't look at public media that snare people with a propaganda of success. Only a few percent of Poles are rich, majority, like in Latin countries just manage to survive to the end of each month. Let's not forget about the millions of Poles who are sick with a disease known as a chronic unemployment. We have to eliminate this disease because in nature people and not capital are of a higher order. There is a need to help our citizens to find work so they can live according to the International Convention of Human Rights. Even on my knees, I will go everywhere and do anything to guarantee my Countrymen chance for a decent life.

Unfriendly press always accuses me that I never had any economic program for Poland. They even state, that living for years abroad I do not know Poland. When I talk about forest, they force me to talk about individual trees. Now that I am a registered presidential candidate, I will have free access to the national radio and TV. I will present my "New Deal for Poland". I know that my old and new electorate, which will vote for me for the first time, is most interested in what I have to say in this election campaign. I realize that what I say at the beginning will be very important. I have been preparing myself for this occasion for the last 10 years.

Future of Poland must not depend on corrupted politicians or foreign mass medias, but only on us Poles, people of a free will. Our will has to be the engine of development and growth. Majority of Poles have never lived in the West, where the laws protect individual rights and there are many shields against predatory exploitation by mean capitalists. The real truth is that highly developed western nations border with socialism when it comes to service and protection of its citizens. This is what should be done in Poland, otherwise we cannot dream about any real development and growth. Social responsibility based on experience must be a base for each effective politician. I know this from years of experience in Canada. I can be strong and effective to implement such an ethical system in Poland.

This is why I count on help of Polish immigrants, who are dedicated and experienced patriots. They can help me in the Office of the President. Naturally I have a good group of valuable people in Poland, serious patriots, who will dedicate their hearts and brains to work hard, not necessarily for their salaries. We have much work to do in order to

implement "New Deal for Poland". I will engage good team of dedicated and effective people so that in a short time we will achieve success, which is expected by our electorate.

Our voters have many questions and inquietudes even before the start of election campaign. I would like to assure you that I will answer all your questions truthfully; even when you may not like all the answers. Much hard work awaits me if I win this election to cooperate with a fragmented Parliament towards a goal of an optimal economic development of Poland. As the situation is most serious, I would like to present myself exactly the way I am. I would like to show you all my advantages and disadvantages so that later on during tedious work on reform of Poland there are no misunderstandings as to my character and my personality.

I hope that much like it was during presidential election in 1990, once gain I will be treated as your "own" man, who has a concrete plan, heart and strength to implement his program for the good of Poland. If I win this election, I will serve you well as the highest official of the nation. I will do all I can to stop suppression and discrimination of Poles in their own country.
